We wish to inform you that in the matter titled *Myotic Trading Pvt. Ltd. vs. Deepak Maini, Resolution Professional of Amzen Transportation Industries Ltd. & Ors.* [Company Appeal (AT) (Ins) No. 859 of 2025], the Hon'ble National Company Law Appellate Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, has vide order dated November 18, 2025 granted final opportunity to Respondents No. 4 and 5 to file their replies to the recall application filed by Cosmic CRF Limited [the Applicant in the said proceedings].

The matter is now listed for further hearing on December 17, 2025, and the interim relief granted vide order dated October 10, 2025 shall continue to remain in force until the next date of hearing.

The order of the Hon'ble NCLAT dated November 18, 2025 has been uploaded today and this intimation is being made immediately upon its receipt.

**ORDER**  
**(Hybrid Mode)**

**18.11.2025:** Ld. Counsel for the Respondent No. 1 submits that he has already filed affidavit vis a vis the application for recall. Ld. Counsel for the Respondent No. 2 submits that he has also filed the reply with regard to the same.

2. Ld. Counsel for Respondent No. 4 (Prudent ARC Ltd.) Shri Sumesh Dhawan, as well as Shri Prateek Kushwaha, Ld. Counsel appearing for Respondent No. 5 (UCO Bank) submits that some reasonable time be granted to them for the purpose of filing reply vis a vis the recall application.

3. We have already recorded in our order dated 10.10.2025 that Respondent No. 6 i.e. WLD Investments Pvt. Ltd. has never appeared before the NCLT nor in any proceedings before this tribunal when the appeal was pending, therefore, in our considered opinion no opportunity was required to be given to him in these proceedings as the only aggrieved party, who had challenged the order of this appellate tribunal was the applicant of this application. In the same order we have also recorded that Respondent No. 7 i.e. FORTUNE GLOBAL SOLUTIONS PVT. LTD. was in consortium with Respondent No. 1 and he has not filed any appeal and therefore his presence would also be irrelevant. Thus, in our considered opinion, there is no need to provide any opportunity to either Respondent No. 6 and 7 so far as the application moved by the applicant for recall of the order of this tribunal passed in CA (AT) (Ins) No. 859 of 2025 is concerned.

4. It has been indicated by Ld. Sr. Counsel appearing for the applicant that we have recorded in our order dated 10.10.2025 that at the behest of the either party application for recall shall not be adjourned.

5. Be that as it may, as we have proceeded to decide the recall application finally and in our considered opinion last opportunity should be provided to the Respondent No. 4 and 5 to file their replies vis a vis the recall application filed by the applicant- Cosmic CRF Ltd.

6. In view of above, we direct to list IA No. 4810, 5965 of 2025 on 17.12.2025.

7. We clarify that the Respondent No. 4 and 5 shall file their reply within two weeks and no more time from today with an advance copy to Ld.

Counsel for the applicant who in turn if so wish may file the rejoinder till the next date of listing.

8. It is again clarified that as these proceedings are commenced under the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court no further opportunity of filing reply shall be provided to any of the Respondents.

9. At this juncture, we notice that the reply which shall be filed by the Respondent No. 2 has been filed with little delay and it is in this background the same has not been taken on record.

10. We direct the office to keep on record the reply filed by the Respondent no. 2. Permission to file the hard copy of the same is also granted to Ld. Counsel for the Respondent No. 2.

11. Interim order dated 10.10.2025 (in para no. 23 of the order) shall remain in operation till the next date of listing.
